STORY OF HAMMER ATTACK

WIFE AND ADOPTED SON WOUNDED

RUSH TO NEIGHBOURS

Youth Describes Scene in the House

AFTER a wife and her adopted son, last afternoon, rushed from a house in Blackpool with head injuries, the police found the husband dead, languishing from a bullet wound.

James Albert Wade (54), of Erdington-road, Central-division, Blackpool.

The discovery was made following a report from a woman who had called to attend to Mrs. Wade (50), wife of the dead man, and her adopted son, 19, the adopted son of Mr. and Mrs. Wade, with whom he lived. His father-in-law is a painter by trade.

Mrs. Wade was taken to the Blackpool Hospital, where she was treated for head injuries alleged to have been sustained by her when she was struck by a hammer by Mr. Wade during a domestic quarrel.
